

Western Province Awards Criteria – Alumni Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc.

- 1. JAMES L. BRADFORD AWARD** – presented to an individual for outstanding service to the Western Province.

CRITERIA:

1. at least five (5) consecutive years of outstanding service to the Western Province.
2. Must have been financial at all levels during this period (including \$100 International Building assessment).
3. Must have been registered, attending, and an active participant in Council meetings (at least 70% attendance in the same period).
4. Candidate abstract must be submitted to the Achievement Commission 30 days prior to the Province Council.

The Achievement will recommend recipient to the Western Province Board of Directors for final approval.

- 2. RANDALL C. BACON ALUMNI ACHIEVEMENT AWARD** – presented to an individual for outstanding achievement as judged by the Achievement Commission.

CRITERIA:

1. Achievement which brings favorable recognition to the Fraternity.
2. Involvement in:
 - community activities
 - intrafraternal activities (Kappa)
 - other achievements and involvement such as church, athletics, business, educational, civic, etc.
3. Current financial member of an Alumni Chapter and in good standing with all levels of the Fraternity, including international housing assessment.

- 3. JAMES O. WHALEY ALUMNI CHAPTER AWARD** – presented to the most outstanding Alumni chapter as judged by the Achievement Commission, based on formal written Chapter Reports.

CRITERIA:

1. Involvement in:
 - intrafraternal activities (Kappa)
 - reclamation/ intake
 - community activities
 - Alumni/ Undergraduate activities
 - Interfraternal/National Pan-Hellenic Council activities
2. Chapter must be financial and in good standing with the Fraternity at all levels, including international housing assessment.

- 4. ALUMNI SCRAPBOOK AWARD** – presented to the Alumni Chapter with the best documentation of chapter activities. Scrapbooks to be judged by the Achievement Commission during the Province Council.

CRITERIA:

1. Scrapbooks must cover the period from the preceding Province Council to the month of the current Province Council.
2. All scrapbooks are to be formally prepared, and are not limited to the traditional book and picture format. The presentation can include video presentation or any other multi-media format.

Note: Presentation is limited to a maximum of ten (10) minutes. Presenter is responsible for obtaining the necessary equipment for the presentation.

5. **JOHN W. REDFUD MEMBERSHIP AWARD** – presented to individuals for continuous financial membership. Based on initial 25 years and every 5 years thereafter.

CRITERIA:

1. Must have been a member of Kappa Alpha Psi for at least 25 years.
2. Must have been financial for a minimum of 5 consecutive years prior to the initial award.

Alumni chapter is responsible for providing names to the Achievement Commission.

There is no limit to the number of names submitted by the Alumni Chapter.

6. **EDWARD L. SHELTON, JR. RECLAMATION AWARD** – presented to the Alumni Chapter with the highest percentage ratio of “Reclaimed Brothers” in relation to the chapter’s current financial membership. (Reclaimed Brother: any member currently financial with an Alumni Chapter who was not financial with that Chapter during the preceding fraternal fiscal year).

7. **ROBERT L. HARRIS, ESQ. PROVINCE POLEMARCH’S AWARD** – presented to an individual for outstanding service to the Western Province. Award recipient(s) determined by the Province Polemarch.

8. **WESTERN PROVINCE ACHIEVEMENT CERTIFICATE** – presented to individuals recommended by their respective chapter to the Achievement Commission.

CRITERIA: determined by each Chapter

9. **KEVIN D. KINSEY COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD** – presented to a chapter for outstanding community service with recommendation/input by the Social Action Committee, and judged by the Achievement Commission.

CRITERIA: may include social action, education, youth, community development, etc.

10. **TOM BRADLEY COMMUNITY SERVICE & DISTINGUISHED CITIZEN AWARD** – presented to selected citizens at each Province Council.

CRITERIA:

1. Minimum 5 years service to the community.
2. Service should deal with all segments of community (community development, youth, senior citizens, education, business, politics)
3. Nominees determined by the Province Council Host Chapter.

TIMELINE FOR AWARD CONSIDERATION

**All information for consideration must be received by the Chairman
of the Western Province Achievement Commission
at least 30 days prior to the start of the Province Council.**

Exceptions:

- Any award whose criteria dictates an earlier submission date.
- Scrapbooks: must be presented to Achievement Commission Chairman no later than 12:00 noon of the first business session.
