

Western Province Awards Criteria - Undergraduate Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc.

1. **E. LIONEL DAVIS UNDERGRADUATE ACHIEVEMENT AWARD** – presented to individual undergraduates for the most outstanding accomplishments as judged by the Achievement Commission.

CRITERIA:

1. Involvement in:
 - community activities
 - school activities
 - achievement which brings favorable recognition to the Fraternity
 - other activities (church, athletics, etc.)
2. Current financial member of active chapter, and in good standing with the Fraternity at all levels.

2. **PETER BUTLER, JR. UNDERGRADUATE CHAPTER ACHIEVEMENT AWARD** – presented to the most outstanding undergraduate chapter as judged by the Achievement Commission, based on formal Chapter Reports.

CRITERIA:

1. Involvement with:
 - infraternal activities
 - membership intake (reclamation)
 - community involvement
 - Alumni/ Undergraduate involvement
 - Interfraternal/ panhellenic council involvement
2. Chapter must be financial and in good standing with the Fraternity at all levels.

3. **SIMEON HOLLOWAY SONGFEST AWARD** – presented to the Undergraduate Chapter winners of the vocal competition during the Undergraduate Luncheon of each Province Council.

CRITERIA:

1. Each contestant (chapter) will sing two songs during the competition.
2. One of the songs must be the Kappa Hymn.

4. **STERLING DOVER UNDERGRADUATE SCRAPBOOK AWARD** – presented to the Undergraduate Chapter with the best documentation of activities. Scrapbooks to be judged by the Achievement Commission during each Province Council.

CRITERIA:

1. Scrapbooks must cover the period from the preceding Province Council to the month of the current Province Council.
2. All scrapbooks are to be formally prepared, and are not limited to traditional book and picture format. The submission can include video or any other multi-media format.

Note: Any presentation will be limited to 10 minutes, and the presenter is responsible for providing any necessary equipment needed for the presentation.

4. **WILLIAM J. MEREDITH OUTSTANDING STUDENT AWARD (GPA)** – presented to the undergraduate member with the highest grade point average among Sophomores (30-59 semester units or 45-89 quarter units), Juniors (60-89 semester units or 90-134 quarter units), and Seniors (90+ semester units or 134+ quarter units).

CRITERIA:

1. Have college send an official sealed transcript to Achievement Commission Chairman at least 30 days prior to Province Council.
2. G.P.A. must be a minimum of 2.5 in a 4.0 system.
3. Evaluation period is the semester or quarter preceding the Province Council.
4. Must be current financial member of an undergraduate chapter, and in good standing with the Fraternity at all levels.

5. **OUTSTANDING CHAPTER G.P.A. AWARD**— presented to the undergraduate chapter with the highest grade point average among all undergraduate chapters.

CRITERIA:

1. Have college send a G.P.A. notice to Achievement Commission Chairman with official seal.
2. G.P.A. must be a minimum of 2.5 in a 4.0 system.
3. G.P.A. notice must contain at least 7 financial members.
4. chapter must be in good standing with the Fraternity at all levels.

6. **KNOWLEDGE BOWL** – a team contest based on general knowledge of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., science, mathematics, history, sports, etc. The Bowl is conducted during each Province Council. Each winning team is awarded a gift.

TIMELINE FOR AWARD CONSIDERATION

**All information for consideration must be received by the Chairman
of the Western Province Achievement Commission
at least 30 days prior to the start of the Province Council.**

Exceptions:

1. Any award whose criteria dictates an earlier submission date.
2. Scrapbooks: must be presented to Achievement Commission Chairman no later than 12:00 noon of the first business session.
3. Songfest: no application is required for the songfest; chapter must be registered for the Province Council and in attendance at the Undergraduate Luncheon.
4. Knowledge Bowl: no application is required for the knowledge bowl; team members must be registered for the Province Council and in attendance at the Knowledge Bowl event.
