**WILLIAM J. MEREDITH OUTSTANDING STUDENT AWARD (GPA)** – presented to the undergraduate member with the highest grade point average among Sophomores (30-59 semester units or 45-89 quarter units), Juniors (60-89 semester units or 90-134 quarter units), and Seniors (90+ semester units or 134+ quarter units).

NOTE: ONE OF THE FOUR RECIPIENTS WILL RECEIVE A \$500 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

CRITERIA:

1. Have college send an official sealed transcript to Achievement Commission Chairman at least 30 days prior to Province Council.
2. G.P.A. must be a minimum of 3.0 in a 4.0 system.
3. Evaluation period is the semester or quarter preceding the Province Council.
4. Must be current financial member of an undergraduate chapter, and in good standing with the Fraternity at all levels.
5. Must be a full-time registered student
6. Complete the following supplement material
  - What do you believe is the most pressing issues in your local community, your country, or the world? Why is this issue(s) compelling to you? (1700 Character or 200 word limit)
  - Proposed Solution to the above problem: (1700 Character or 200 word limit)
  - Major Obstacles/Implementation Challenges [Do not discuss how your proposal overcomes these challenges]: (800 Characters or 100 word limit)

Send all material in one packet to Achievement Commission Chairman at least 30 days prior to Province Council.

**CURTIS R. SILVERS, JR. CIVIC MERIT SCHOLAR AWARD**- presented to an undergraduate for their incessant civic involvement both on and off campus, going against all odds and being exemplary students in all fields of human endeavor

NOTE: ONE RECIPIENT WILL RECEIVE A \$500 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

CRITERIA:

1. Involvement in:
  - community activities
  - school activities
  - achievement which brings favorable recognition to the Fraternity
  - other activities (church, athletics, etc.)
2. Have college send an official sealed transcript to Achievement Commission Chairman at least 30 days prior to Province Council.
3. G.P.A. must be a minimum of 2.5 in a 4.0 system.
4. Evaluation period is the semester or quarter preceding the Province Council.

5. Must be current financial member of an undergraduate chapter, and in good standing with the Fraternity at all levels.

6. Must be a full-time registered student

7. Complete the following supplement material (Times Roman Numeral, 12pt Font, Double-Spaced)

- Describe one specific example of your leadership. Limit 2000 characters including spaces.
- Describe a recent particularly satisfying public service activity. Limit 1700 characters including spaces
